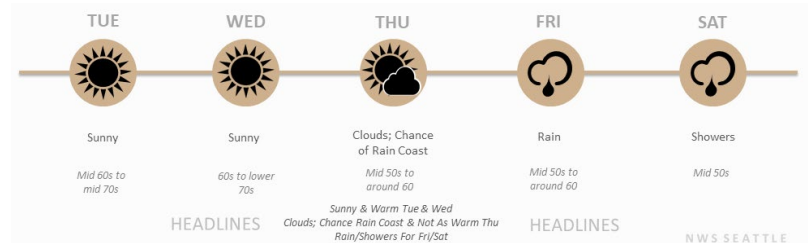

RECORD TEMPS | SPRING FLOODING

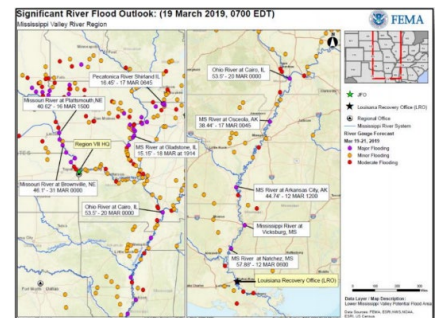
SUMMARY: Warm temps, rain by weekend, major river flooding Missouri and Mississippi basins.

WEATHER: Sunny and warm weather Tuesday and Wednesday, record high temperatures likely. Thursday clouds with chance of rain on coast. Rain Friday and Saturday, temperatures near to above normal.



NATIONAL INCIDENTS:

Missouri and Mississippi River basins - NE rivers have crested or are expected to crest in 24-48 hours. FEMA supporting local operations. Red River expected to cause major flooding.



INTERNATIONAL INCIDENTS:

CHRISTCHURCH, New Zealand - Remains on High Alert following last week's terror attack killing over 50 people.

RIVERS: All are at normal levels as of 19MAR19.

VOLCANIC ACTIVITY: CVO Cascade Range **GREEN**/NORMAL - All volcanoes are at normal levels.
