FIRE RISK HIGH | 80'S | HEAT SAFETY

AIR QUALITY WIND GUSTS EXCESSIVE HEAT FIRE WEATHER RIVER FLOODING

SUMMARY: High temperatures in the high 70's to mid to high 80's remain consistent throughout the week. Fire danger is HIGH for both Western and Eastern Washington. Use extreme caution operating motorized equipment or vehicles in woodland areas.

















WEATHER: Cloudy, gradually becoming sunny, high near 77. Wednesday mostly sunny, high near 81. Thursday mostly sunny, high near 82. Higher wind gust of 24 mph possible Friday. Sustained excessive heat can cause heat related illnesses. Monitor children, elderly and pets for proper hydration and never leave children and or pets in cars.
