FOG | 60'S | CLOUDY | PR M6.0 QUAKE



SUMMARY: Morning fog again in some areas. Magnitude 6.0 earthquake near Puerto Rico as Tropical Storm Karen is expected to cross near or over the island.



WEATHER: Next five days will see a chance of showers for parts of Western Washington. Highs in the 60s to near 70 for Tuesday through Thursday, then will cool down into the upper 50s to mid-60s for Friday and Saturday.

Tropical Cyclone Karen is forecast pass near or over the U.S. Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico today. A Tropical Storm Warning is in effect for the U.S. Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico. Rainfall accumulations of 2 to 4 inches, with isolated 8



inches, may cause flash flooding and mudslides.
