EXCESSIVE HEAT | 90'S | HOT AND DRY

AIR QUALITY FIRE WEATHER RIVER FLOODING WIND GUSTS EXCESSIVE HEAT

GOOD NONE NONE 8-10 MPH 90's

<u>SUMMARY:</u> Excessive Heat Advisory for Tuesday thru Thursday. Cooling centers advised for at risk populations.



WEATHER: EXCESSIVE HEAT - Temperatures are expected to climb into the lower to mid-80s on Tuesday then reach their warmest on Wednesday with highs in the upper 80s to lower 90s. This will elevate heat risk to a point where sensitive groups would be prone to health issues.



Wednesday will see a "moderate heat risk" for people sensitive to heat-people who do not have an effective way to cool down or who are not adequately hydrated. A push of marine air on Thursday should help knock the high temps back down into the 70s for the end of the week.

FIRE WEATHER FORECAST: As of June 10th Western WA remains at little to no risk while Eastern WA close to Idaho has areas at Low Risk. No active fires at this time.
