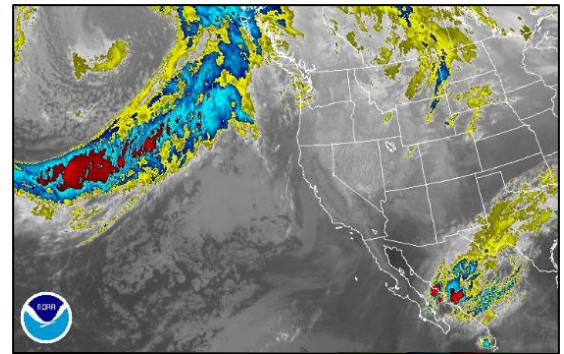
BE STORM READY | PARTLY SUNNY | 60'S
