
ACTIVE INCIDENTS:

WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY | RAIN

SUMMARY: Winter Weather Advisory for the Cascade Mountains, rain for low lands, wind gusts Tuesday into Wednesday may cause local power outages.

WEATHER: Snow for the Cascade Mountains. Heavier snow accumulations expected over the West Slopes of the Cascades from Snohomish County Southward. Rain showers and breezy winds continue. Convergence zone weather may impact Western King, Snohomish & Pierce counties. Highs: mid to upper 40s. Wednesday drier.
