## WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY | RAIN

**SUMMARY:** Winter Weather Advisory for the Cascade Mountains, rain for low lands, wind gusts Tuesday into Wednesday may cause local power outages.

**WEATHER:** Snow for the Cascade Mountains. Heavier snow accumulations expected over the West Slopes of the Cascades from Snohomish County Southward. Rain showers and breezy winds continue. Convergence zone weather may impact Western King, Snohomish & Pierce counties. Highs: mid to upper 40s. Wednesday drier.

**Winter Weather Headlines**

A Winter Weather Advisory remains in effect for the Cascades of Whatcom & Skagit counties above 1500 feet until Noon Tuesday.

A Winter Storm Warning remains in effect for the Cascades of Snohomish, King, Pierce & Lewis counties above 2000 feet until Noon Tuesday.

**DETAILS**

Cascades of Whatcom & Skagit counties: Snow accumulations of 8-15 inches possible.

Cascades of Snohomish, King, Pierce & Lewis counties: Snow accumulations up to 20 inches possible.

- Heaviest snowfall looks to occur Monday night & early Tuesday morning.
- Snow covered roads & limited visibilities with difficult travel conditions and delays possible.
