COLD | WIND CHILL | POWER OUTAGES

WESTERN WASHINGTON

SUMMARY: Gusty winds up to 50 mph reported in Enumclaw with localized power outages. Temperatures around the region as low as 27 degrees. Wind chill for some areas reached between 4 to 12 degrees above zero. Cold temps prompting Warming Shelter openings. PNW Wildland Fire Task Force's continues to deploy to CA.


















WEATHER: Near to below freezing morning temperatures for the next several days, lows the upper 20s to mid-30s. Strong easterly winds through this afternoon, especially for the foothills of the Cascades. Gusts to 50 mph reported.



WIND CHILL: Wind gusts reached 50 mph overnight with regional temps as low as 27 degrees. Exposure to cold temps and wind can lead to hypothermia rapidly, a life-threatening condition.



<u>CALIFORNIA WILDFIRES:</u> PNW Wildland Fire teams deploying to Northern California to assist in multiple wildfires burning across the state.



PHILIPPINES QUAKE:

Several powerful earthquakes have damaged buildings and knocked out power to hardest hit communities. The largest was a 6.6 magnitude quake followed by a 6.1 quake.
