WESTERN WASHINGTON
AIR QUALITY FIRE WEATHER RIVER FLOODING WIND GUSTS EXCESSIVE HEAT
MODERATE HIGH FIRE RISK NONE 6-12 80-90'S

<u>SUMMARY</u>: High 80's to low 90's across the region. High fire risk. Afternoon mountain thunderstorms. Join your local law enforcement for **National Night Out** and meet your neighbors! Health advisory for children, elderly, and pets for heat related illness during excessive heat periods.



<u>WEATHER:</u> Partly cloudy in some areas with high temperatures in the high 80's to low 90's. Temps will begin to moderate later in the week with partly cloudy skies. Rain possible Friday. Mid to high 70's for the weekend.



NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL: The National Interagency Fire Center (NIFC) has raised from the National Preparedness Level (PL) from level 2 to level 3 on a scale of 1-5, 5 being the highest. The level represents the depletion of nationally available wildland firefighting resources.
