## E. WA LIGHTNING | 80'S | PL LOWERED 2

WESTERN WASHINGTON

AIR QUALITY FIRE WEATHER RIVER FLOODING WIND GUSTS EXCESSIVE HEAT

GOOD HIGH RISK NONE 6-10 80's

**SUMMARY**: Warm and dry across the region with high clouds and less than 10% chance of precipitation. Fire danger remains **HIGH**. Lightning in Eastern Washington may bring new fire starts. **Excessive Heat: Monitor elderly, children, and pets for heat related illnesses.** 



**WEATHER:** Dry weather continues rest of the week and through the weekend. Clouds gradually increase, high temperatures will decrease into the weekend. **Eastern Washington:** Lightning strikes possible Thursday morning. Dry lightning and new fire starts will be the potential hazards with thunderstorms.



**NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL (PL):** Due to a **decrease** in wildfire activity throughout the country, the National Preparedness Level will be lowered to 2 at 2pm MDT today.
