## FOG | 1<sup>ST</sup> DAY OF FALL | 60'S | CLOUDY

AIR QUALITY FIRE WEATHER FLOODING WIND GUSTS

**SUMMARY**: Morning fog in some area with some breezy conditions and cloudy. Cold front later this week bringing freezing temps to Spokane. Puerto Rico under tropical storm watch. Tropical Storm Kiko no threat to Hawaii.


















**WEATHER:** Today, areas of fog before 11am. Otherwise, mostly cloudy, with a high near 63. Southwest wind 10 to 14 mph. **Tuesday**, mostly cloudy, with a high near 68. Wednesday, mostly sunny, with a high near 67.

## TROPICAL CYCLONE UPDATE:

Atlantic-Topical Cyclone Karen - Tropical Storm Watch in effect for the US Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico. Pacific- TS Kiko weakening, no threat to Hawaii.



**COLD TEMPERATURES RETURNS:** Spokane, WA - An unseasonably cold storm system is on track to impact the Inland NW late this week. Winter-like conditions over the mountains and lowland frost/freeze will be possible.
