80's | EXCESSIVE HEAT | BRUSH FIRES

WESTERN WASHINGTON


AIR QUALITY FIRE WEATHER RIVER FLOODING WIND GUSTS EXCESSIVE HEAT

GOOD HIGH RISK NONE 8-15 80's

SUMMARY: Regional temperatures continue in the 80's. **Monitor elderly, children and pets during excessive heat.**



WEATHER: Mostly sunny, with a high near or above 80 degrees in some areas. Thursday partly sunny, with a high near 80. Warm and dry weather will continue through the weekend for Western Washington.



EXCESSIVE HEAT DANGER: Regional temperatures will remain near or above 80 degrees in Western Washington. Daytime high temps pose a risk even for a short time to children, and pets. **Never leave them alone!**



REGIONAL BRUSH FIRES: Several aggressive and fast moving brush fires were reported in the last 24 hours. As warm dry weather returns extreme caution is advised. Burn bans remain in effect throughout the region. See smoke call 911.
