AIR QUALITY FIRE WEATHER RIVER FLOODING WIND GUSTS EXCESSIVE HEAT



SUMMARY: Are you prepared for an earthquake? After California's 7.1 magnitude earthquake officials are reviewing regional preparedness. Overnight rain changing to showers across the region. Temperatures mid 70's to 80 in some areas.



<u>WEATHER:</u> Showers with high near 73. Winds 5 to 8 mph. Chance of precipitation is 80%. Thursday a 20 percent chance of showers. Partly sunny, with a high near 77.

TROPICAL DEPRESSION: There is now a 90% chance of a tropical depression forming in the Gulf of Mexico during the next couple of days. Watches could be required for a portion of the Gulf Coast on Wednesday. When tropical storms form Northwest Response resources are placed on standby or deployed to aid other states.
