## 5.4M OREGON QUAKE | 70'S | CLOUDY

WESTERN WASHINGTON
AIR QUALITY FIRE WEATHER RIVER FLOODING WIND GUSTS EXCESSIVE HEAT
GOOD MODERATE NONE 6-10 70's

**SUMMARY**: 5.2 magnitude earthquake off Oregon Coast. Cooler temperatures across most of the region with high clouds and less than 10% chance of precipitation. 22 new wildland fires in the Northwest in the last 24 hours.



<u>WEATHER:</u> Partly sunny, high near 74. Saturday mostly cloudy, high near 74. Sunday partly sunny, high near 75. Monday partly sunny, with a high near 78.



## **OREGON COAST EARTHQUAKE:**

A magnitude 5.4 earthquake occurred 225 miles off the Oregon Coast at sea with a depth of 6.2 miles located near the Blanco Fracture Zone. No threat of tsunami for coastal areas. This region experiences shallow quakes frequently.



## **WILDLAND FIRE ACTIVITY:**

15AUG19 - There has been 22 new wildfires that have ignited in the Northwest area in the last 24 hours. One of them turned into a large incident, while there are still 7 wildfires still burning in this area. Source: NW Fire Blog
