DRYER | MOUNTAIN THUNDERSTORMS

AIR QUALITY	FIRE WEATHER	RIVER FLOODING	WIND GUSTS	EXCESSIVE HEAT

SUMMARY: Dryer conditions raise wildland fire danger. Cold water death reported locally, lakes and rivers remain cold enough to kill. Thunderstorms periodically around the region. See lightening, go inside!



<u>WEATHER:</u> The Cascades could see some showers with isolated thunderstorms in the afternoon and evening. Today cloudy AM, sunny afternoon, high near 69. Thursday is mostly sunny, high near 71. Friday mostly sunny, with a high near 71. Cold water danger remains HIGH.

FIRE WEATHER: NO active fire weather alerts for the region at this time, however warmer dryer weather will create optimal fire conditions. Next issuance of the Significant Wildland Fire Potential Outlook is June 1st. Reduce wildland fire interface risk, prepare your home now. Be Firewise!
