
ACTIVE INCIDENTS:

RAIN RETURNS | SPRING DRIER WARMER

SUMMARY: Rain returns to the area today, NWS Spring forecast drier and warmer, brush fire responses continue with over 50 responses this week.

DRIER & WARMER SPRING:

NWS released their forecast model showing a drier and warmer Spring which will cause more concern for an active wildfire season. Brush fires have already been active in Western Washington.




RIVERS: All are at normal levels as of 21MAR19.
