WESTERN WASHINGTON

AIR QUALITY FIRE WEATHER RIVER FLOODING WIND GUSTS EXCESSIVE HEAT

GOOD MODERATE RISK NONE 8-10 70's

SUMMARY: Damaging thunderstorms caused Flash Flooding in Central and Eastern Washington. Temperatures will begin to warm with highs in the mid to high 70's. Fire Risk forecasted to increase following 4th of July holiday.











WEATHER: A 20 % chance of rain before 8am. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 72. South wind 5 to 8 mph becoming west in the afternoon. Independence Day mostly cloudy, with a high near 75. South wind 5 to 9 mph.



DAMAGE ASSESSMENTS:

Central | Eastern Washington Flash Flood Warnings were issued for multiple areas yesterday for slow moving thunderstorms which caused fast rising water and mud slides in fire scared areas.



WILDLAND FIRE RISK:

Following the July 4th holiday celebrations an increase in fire risk is forecast for most of Western, Central, and Eastern Washington. Danger from unused fireworks is HIGH.
