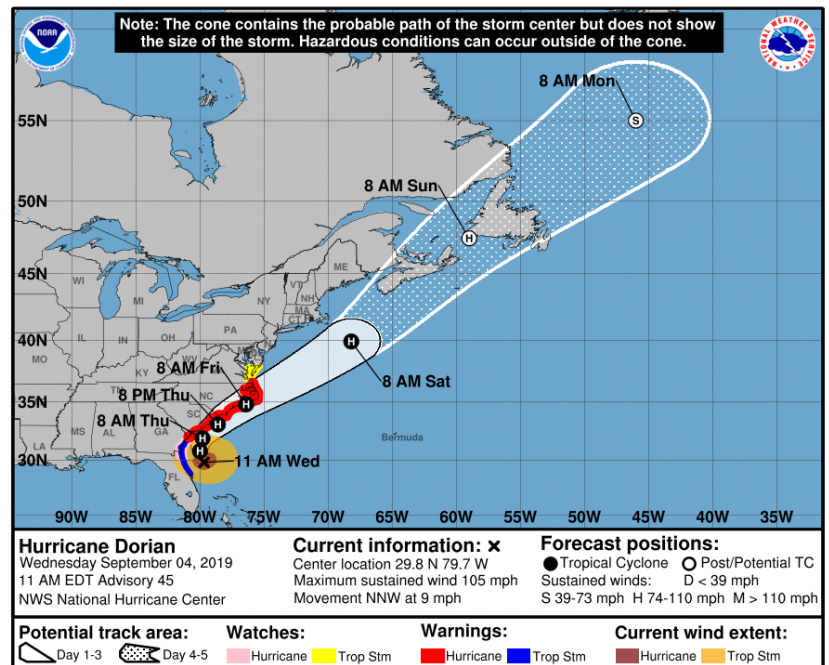
## DORIAN UPDATE | 80'S | THUNDERSTORM

**SUMMARY:** Hurricane Dorian caused catastrophic damage in the Bahamas. Currently moving north along the US mainland seaboard. States of emergency have been declared for Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, North Carolina, and Virginia. US based Urban Search & Rescue teams currently active in the Bahamas.

## HURRICANE DORIAN:

Category 2 hurricane - Hurricane warnings now stretch to the North Carolina-Virginia border. Hilton Head hospital closes ahead of Dorian. Hundreds of Bahamian troops sent to Abaco. Miami sends first responders and donated goods to Bahamas. Nearly 400,000 residents are under mandatory evacuation order in North Carolina. Delta Airlines will resume flights in Orlando and West Palm Beach today.
