WESTERN WASHINGTON

AIR QUALITY FIRE WEATHER FLOODING WIND GUSTS FREEZING TEMPS

GOOD NONE NONE 13-15 30 mph 40's

**SUMMARY**: Possible AM thunderstorms and again, late PM. The main threats with these storms will be brief downpours, isolated lightning strikes, and wind gusts up to 30 mph. Get ready for the Great Washington ShakeOut!



















WEATHER: Showers likely, possible thunderstorms. High near 61. Winds 13 to 15 mph. Friday a 40 percent chance of showers. Partly sunny, with a high near 61. East of the Cascades, breezy winds are expected Friday afternoon. Gusts will

generally be 20 to 30 mph with local gusts near 35 mph in the mountains and higher benches. Strongest winds will impact the Cascade East Slopes, Columbia Basin, Palouse, and the Blue Mountains.
