RED FLAG WARNING FOR WA | TEMPS NEAR 80'S | COLD WATER DANGER HIGH

SUMMARY: Red Flag Warning expanded into SW Washington. Regional temps near 80. Wildland fire responses increasing. Cold water immersion danger HIGH.

<u>FIRE WEATHER:</u> Red Flag Warning expanded into SW Washington. This warning may be grow over the weekend to include areas closer to Olympia, Tacoma, and Seattle.

FIRE PREVENTION: Warm and dry weather conditions are expected into the weekend. Those planning to head out for outdoor recreation this weekend should be aware of the fire danger. Heed all fire restrictions and use caution with fire triggers (grills, cars, campfires, etc.).



<u>AIR QUALITY:</u> GOOD – No impacts detected. AS wildland fire smoke increases this section will report impacts.

FLOOD WATCH: Western Washington at normal levels. Naches River <u>eastern Washington river</u>, <u>near flood stage</u>.
