

DROUGHT EMERGENCY | 2.5M QUAKE

SUMMARY: Gov. Inslee expands Drought Emergency declaration to nearly half of Washington. A magnitude 2.5 earthquake near Neah Bay, WA. Warmer weather ahead.

EARTHQUAKE: A 2.5 magnitude earthquake was report 25km SE of Neah Bay, Washington on Monday, May 20th, 2019 at 13:35:56 PT. Event occurred on land near coast.



DROUGHT EMERGENCY: Washington Gov. Jay Inslee on Monday expanded the drought emergency to cover nearly half of the state, citing poor water supply conditions along with warmer and drier weather expected through the summer. https://bit.ly/2WeCLHO
